Newly founded Non-Profit hosts First Annual 5k Run/Walk

Newton, MA – The Paul St Martin Charitable Corporation (PSMCC) will host their first annual 5k Run/Walk on Sunday May 24th, 2009 at Weeks Field in Newton Centre to raise funds for advanced research for heart disease.

Runners and walkers of all levels and ages are welcome to participate. Opening ceremonies are scheduled to begin at 8 AM on Paul Street with an awards ceremony immediately following the race. According to Kristen St. Martin who founded the non-profit to assure that her father’s spirit of helping those in need and the lasting impression he left on all would continue for years, Paul Street is an ideal start and finish line for the race as it was the first street on Paul’s daily morning run.

Participants are encouraged to pre-register at paulstmartincharitablecorp.com. The first 300 registrants will receive free race t-shirts. The registration fee is \$25 before May 15th and \$30 after through race day. All proceeds from registration fees will fund grants for heart disease research.
